# Fancy Yarn Ponytail Holders

## MATERIALS NEEDED

- Yarn
- Crochet hook appropriate for yarn (package around yarn will suggest crochet hook size)
- Elastic ponytail holder(s)
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

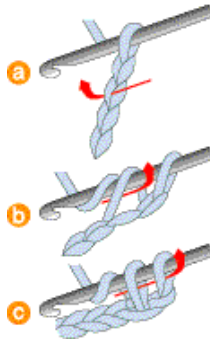


These are the kind we use.

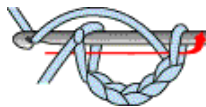


## STITCHES USED

**Sc = single crochet:** insert hook in stitch (a), yarn over, draw loop through (b), yarn over, draw through both loops on hook (c).



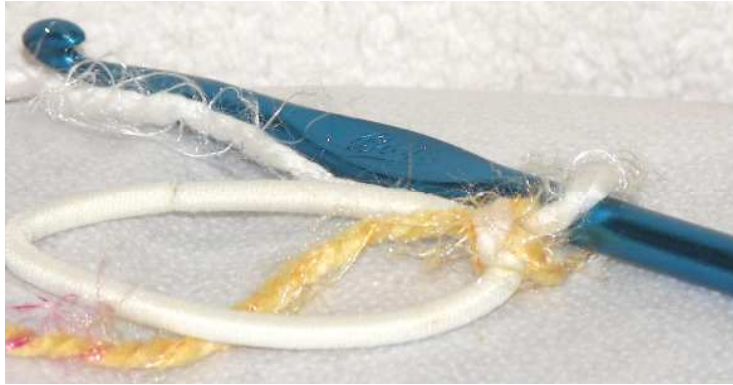
**Sl st = slip stitch:** insert hook in stitch, yarn over, draw through loop on hook.



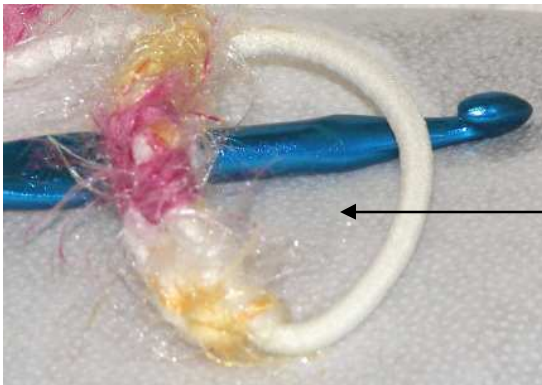
## Fancy Yarn Ponytail Holders

### PATTERN

1. Attach yarn to elastic ponytail holder by working 1 sc.



2. With proper hook for chosen yarn, sc around entire ponytail holder. As you get more stitches on the ponytail holder, push them to the right with your fingers so that you have plenty of room to add more stitches. Be sure to completely cover ponytail holder.



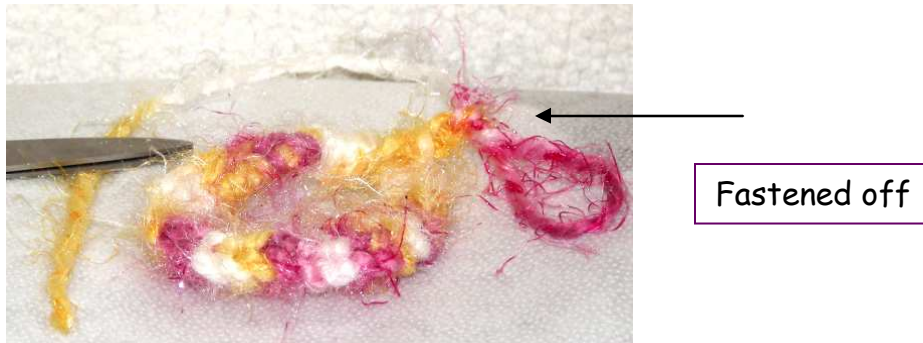
Half covered

## Fancy Yarn Ponytail Holders

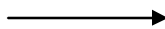
3. Once elastic ponytail holder is completely covered (you can't push over any more stitches) slip stitch to first sc and fasten off. *To fasten off, cut the yarn leaving a few inches of tail. Next, with your crochet hook, draw the tail through the loop on your hook. Remove hook and pull on tail to tighten it.*



4. Next, with your yarn needle, weave tail into stitches to hide.
