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Ladybug Wristlet Purse Crochet Pattern

MATERIALS

- E crochet hook
- G crochet hook
- Worsted weight yarn
 - Black
 - Red
- Fiberfill
- Wiggle eyes (7 mm)
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- Black felt
- Craft glue
- Stitch marker or safety pin

STITCHES USED

- Ch = chain
- Sc = single crochet
- Sc dec = single crochet together 2 stitches
- Hdc = half double crochet
- Sl st = slip stitch
- St = stitch
- Sts = stitches
- FO = fasten off



PATTERN NOTES

1. This pattern is worked in a continuous spiral stitch. You will need to mark the last st of the round with a stitch marker or safety pin. Do not join rounds!
2. We also suggest keeping an extra safety pin handy to hold your working stitch when you need to put your project down.
3. This pattern is worked in 2 parts - the ladybug's body and the ladybug's head. After the two parts are made, they are sewn together using your yarn needle.
4. This wristlet can easily be turned into a purse by making a longer drawstring!

PATTERN

*****We are starting with the Ladybug's body first. Begin with black yarn and G crochet hook.*****

Round 1: Ch 2. 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (6 sc)

Round 2: 2 sc in each sc around. (12 sc)

Round 3: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc*, repeat from * to * around. (18 sc)

Round 4: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc*, repeat from * to * around. (24 sc) 2

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Round 5: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc*, repeat from * to * around. (30 sc)

Round 6: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc*, repeat from * to * around. (36 sc)

Round 7: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc*, repeat from * to * around. (42 sc)

Round 8: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc*, repeat from * to * around. (48 sc)

Round 9: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 7 sc*, repeat from * to * around. (54 sc)

*****Change to Red yarn*****

Round 10: Sc in the **BACK** loop of each sc around. (54 sc)

Rounds 11-19: Sc in each sc around. (54 sc)

Round 20: *Ch 2, skip next sc, sc in next sc*, repeat from * to * around.

To Finish: Sl st in first ch-2 sp, FO and weave in all tails.

DRAWSTRING

1. Using red yarn, ch 100.
2. Sl st in 2nd ch from hook and each remaining ch.
3. FO and weave in tails.
4. Insert drawstring through eyelet row (round 20)
5. Knot drawstring ends together making sure the loop is large enough to fit comfortably on wrist.

HEAD

*****Use black yarn and G crochet hook.*****

Round 1: Ch 2. 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (6 sc)

Round 2: 2 sc in each sc around. (12 sc)

Round 3: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc*, repeat from * to * around. (18 sc)

Rounds 4-6: Sc in each sc around. (18 sc)

Round 7: *Sc dec, sc in next sc*, repeat from * to * around. (12 sc)

*****Stuff head being careful not to overstuff.*****

Round 8: Sc dec around. (6 sc)

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To Finish:

1. Sl st in next st. FO, leaving a length of tail for sewing.
2. Use tail to sew opening shut.
3. Do NOT cut tail. This tail will be used to later sew head to body.
4. Set head aside for now.

ANTENNAE (make 2)

1. With black yarn and E hook, ch 5. 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Sc in last 3 sts.
2. FO, leaving a length of tail for sewing.
3. Sew antennae to head.

To Finish Head:

1. Glue wiggle eyes on the front of head with strong glue or hot glue.
2. Sew head to the purse.

DOTS

1. Cut 9 dots out of black felt. We used a small chapstick lid for our circle template.
2. Using hot glue or strong craft glue, attach dots to purse.
3. Allow glue to completely dry and you are finished! ☺
