# Watermelon Wristlet Crochet Pattern

## MATERIALS NEEDED

- F crochet hook
- G crochet hook
- Worsted weight yarn: (green, red, white)
- 40 black pony beads
- Yarn needle
- Green stiffened felt for base (optional - we found our stiffened felt at Hobby Lobby)

## STITCHES USED

- Ch = chain
- St = stitch
- Sts = stitches
- Sl st = slip stitch
- FO = fasten off
- Sc = single crochet
- BSC = beaded single crochet

## STITCH EXPLANATION:

**BSC - Beaded Single Crochet:** Pull bead up close to work. Keeping the bead in front of your work, insert hook in the stitch behind the bead and pull up a loop. YO (yarn over) and pull through both loops on your hook. The bead should now be on the top of the stitch and front side of purse.

## PATTERN NOTES:

- This pattern is worked in a continuous spiral stitch. Mark the last stitch of the round with a safety pin or stitch marker.
- We also suggest that you keep an extra safety pin handy to attach to the working stitch when you need to put your project down. This will secure and hold the stitch in place until you work on your project again.
- Finished size is approximately 4" in height by 3 1/2" in diameter. If you would like a larger purse, use an H crochet hook. Note: if making a larger purse, you will also need to increase the number of pony beads and chains for drawstring.

## PATTERN

**\*\*We will begin at the bottom of the watermelon, which is the bottom of the purse. Start with green yarn and your G crochet hook.\*\***

**Round 1:** Ch 2. 7 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (7 sc)

**Round 2:** 2 sc in each sc around. (14 sc)

**Round 3:** \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc\*, repeat from \* to \* around. (21 sc)

**Round 4:** \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc\*, repeat from \* to \* around. (28 sc)

**Round 5:** \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc\*, repeat from \* to \* around. (35 sc)

**Round 6:** \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc\*, repeat from \* to \* around. (42 sc)

**Round 7:** \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc\*, repeat from \* to \* around. (49 sc)

**Round 8:** \*2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc\*, repeat from \* to \* around. (56 sc)

**Round 9:** Sc in the BACK loop of each sc around. (56 sc)

**Rounds 10-12:** Sc in each sc around. (56 sc)

***\*\*Change to white yarn.\*\****

**Rounds 13-14:** Sc in each sc around. (56 sc)

***\*\*String 40 black pony beads on red yarn. Change to red yarn.\*\****

**Round 15:** With red yarn, sc in each sc around. (56 sc)

**Round 16:** \*Sc in next 3 sc, BSC in next sc\*, repeat from \* to \* around. End with 1 sc in last sc. (43 sc, 13 BSC)

**Round 17:** Sc in each sc around. (56 sc)

**Round 18:** Sc in next sc, BSC in next sc. \*Sc in next 3 sc, BSC in next sc\*, repeat from \* to \* around. End with a sc in last 2 sc. (42 sc, 14 BSC)

**Round 19:** Sc in each sc around. (56 sc)

**Round 20:** \*Sc in next 3 sc, BSC in next sc\*, repeat from \* to \* around. End with 1 sc in last sc. (43 sc, 13 BSC)

**Round 21:** Sc in each sc around. (56 sc)

**Round 22:** \*Ch 2, skip next sc, sc in next sc\*, repeat from \* to \* around. Sl st in first ch-2 sp, FO and weave in all tails.

### DRAWSTRING

1. With red yarn and F crochet hook, ch 80.
2. Sl st in 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook and each ch across.
3. Fasten off, leaving a length of tail for sewing.
4. Weave drawstring through eyelet row (round 22).
5. Sew drawstring ends together.
6. Pull drawstring through eyelet row until the sewn ends are positioned in the back of purse.

## OPTIONAL BOTTOM INSERT

1. To give the bottom of the purse a hard bottom, simply purchase stiffened felt, cut to fit and insert in bottom of purse.
2. Or, you can cut out a piece of cardboard to fit in the bottom of purse and cover it with felt, fabric, etc. Be sure glue is dry before inserting the bottom piece. Craft glue or hot glue works well for adhering felt to cardboard.
